The Christian Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament (Christian CND) is an ecumenical organisation made up of lay people, clergy and members of religious orders, working together to get rid of nuclear weapons.

- They cause environmental pollution that can last up to 500,000 years.
- They cause genetic damage that is passed on to future generations.
- They destroy the very building blocks of life God created.

Christian CND works to inform Christians and the churches about nuclear weapons.  
Christian CND holds special Peace Liturgies, publishes information, organises day schools on nuclear issues, and dialogues with decision makers.
